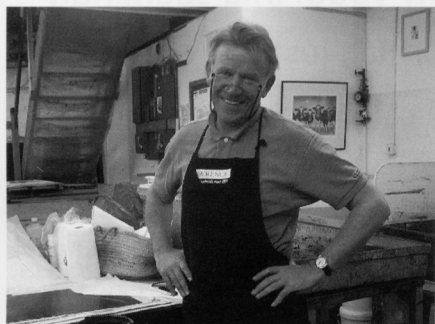


ARTISTS' TALKS

Bryan Poole is a New Zealand born, botanical and natural history illustrator /printmaker, specialising in etching. He has been working in the UK since the early 1980s and was recently elected a Member of the Royal Society of Painter-

Printmakers. His work appears in many public collections including the Ashmolean Museum, Oxford, the Natural History Museum, London and the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew.

2.30pm Carole Hensher



London artist, Carole Hensher ARE, studied post-graduate printmaking at Camberwell College of Art. Carole works in a variety of media, but primarily lithography, dry-point and etching. An Associate of the Royal Society of Painter-

Printmakers and a Member of the Printmakers Council, she also belongs to the South Bank and Greenwich Printmakers organisations, and regularly works at Artichoke and the London Print Studio. Carole is a frequent contributor to Printmaking Today magazine.
